## GRE

Dear Student.

Taking the **Graduate Record Examinations** is a major step towards securing your place in a top graduate school. The **GRE** has been developed as a precise indicator of general aptitude and language skills.

#### What is the GRE?

The **Graduate Record Examination** (known as **GRE**) is conducted by the Education Testing Service (ETS) on behalf of the Graduate Record Examination Board and Council of Graduate Schools. The **GRE** is generally taken by those students who want to take admission in any foreign university for Graduate or some PhD. programmes. The pattern of the exam is mostly objective with multiple-choice questions. The **GRE** score is an important criterion for taking admission in one of the foreign universities.

#### Who can take the GRE?


Any applicant who has started his/her under graduation can appear for the test. The scores are valid for five years.

#### The GRE structure

- One Analytical Writing (Essay Writing) section with two separately timed writing tasks.
- Two Verbal Reasoning (English) sections.
- Two Quantitative Reasoning (Mathematics) sections.

The GRE revised General Test more closely reflects the kind of thinking you'll do in graduate or business school and demonstrates that you are ready for graduate-level work.

- Verbal Reasoning measures your ability to analyze and evaluate written material and synthesize information obtained
  from it, analyze relationships among component parts of sentences and recognize relationships among words and
  concepts.
- Quantitative Reasoning measures problem-solving ability, focusing on basic concepts of Arithmetic, Algebra, Geometry and Data analysis.
- Analytical Writing Assessment measures critical thinking and analytical writing skills, specifically your ability to
  articulate and support/oppose complex ideas.

Taking the Scholastic Assessment Test is a major step towards securing your place in the best under-grad schools in the U.S. The SAT has been developed in order to measure Mathematical, Verbal, and Writing skills.

#### What is the SAT and Why is it taken?


- The SAT or Scholastic Assessment Test, is a standardized test published and administered by the College Board (www.collegeboard.org).
- The SAT is often required to make admission related decisions for following countries:
  - USA Australia UK Singapore
- However, it is just one factor in the admission related decisions. Schools also consider your high school GPA, academic transcripts, letters of recommendation, interviews, and personal essays.
- The SAT plays a major role in securing scholarships.


#### Who can take the SAT and When?

- Any applicant, who is pursuing his/her Higher Secondary, can appear for the test.
- The SAT is offered nationally every year in March, May, October, and December.

#### **About the SAT**

- The SAT is a test of your knowledge within the core areas of reading, writing and mathematics.
- Each section is scored on a 200 to 800 point scale, making the "perfect" score 1600.
- Essay Writing (Optional): You will be given a passage of 650-700 words and you will have to analyze & then explain how author's argument is organized.

## **IELTS**

Dear student,

Taking **IELTS** is a major step towards securing your place in a top undergraduate and graduate school. The **IELTS** has been developed as a precise indicator of the aspirant's verbal ability and language skills.

#### What is IELTS?

**IELTS** i.e. **International English Language Testing System** is a standardized English proficiency test. It assesses English Language skills in the areas of listening, reading, writing and speaking. It is jointly owned by the British Council, IDP and University of Cambridge ESOL EXAMINATIONS.

**IELTS** has two variations. The Academic module is for students who either want to pursue undergraduate or postgraduate courses or have professional reasons. The General Training Module is for people who either wish to join vocational courses or want to immigrate. Overall, the general test is easier than the academic test.

Performance in each section (Reading, Listening, Speaking and Writing) is rated on 9 bands. The final **IELTS** score is the average of the scores secured in the individual sections.

Listening: The Listening test is same for both Academic and General training test takers. The test consists of four sections. The recording is played only once. The test is of 30 minutes. The test takers are given 10 minutes extra to transfer the answers to the answer sheet.

**Reading:** The Reading test is different for Academic candidates and General candidates. The Academic reading has 3 long passages whereas the General reading has 4-5 passages.

Writing: The Writing task is different for Academic and General test takers. In Academic, the first task (atleast 150 words) is to describe a graph/table/chart/diagram whereas, in General, the first task is to write a letter (atleast 150 words). However, the second writing task is to write an essay (atleast 250 words) which is common for both Academic and General test takers.

**Speaking**: The Speaking test consists of a personal interview that lasts between 11 - 15 minutes. All the speaking tests are recorded. The topics asked are usually close to real-life situations.

#### What is TOEFL?

**TOEFL** i.e. **Test of English as a Foreign Language** is a standardized English proficiency test that assesses English Language skills in the areas of listening, reading, writing and speaking. Candidates desirous of pursuing further studies at undergraduate or graduate levels are required to take **TOEFL** to demonstrate their English proficiency.


